

MLA Citation style: Works Cited

Website



-  **Author(s):** Write the author last name, followed by a comma, their first name and sometimes middle initial, followed by a period. If there is a second author, write "and", followed by their first and last name, followed by a period.
-  **Title:** Write the title of the article, followed by a period. Place quotation marks on both sides of the title with the period inside.
-  **Company:** If available, write the title of the company in italics, followed by a comma.
-  **Date:** Write the day, abbreviated month and year in which the article was published, followed by a comma.
-  **Website address:** Write the exact URL of the article, followed by a period. Omit the "http". If a permalink is available, use this instead of the URL.
-  **Date accessed:** Write "Accessed", followed by the day, abbreviated month and year that the website was accessed. End this section with a period.
