Formatting: Double-space your reference list and use a 0.5 inch hanging indent for each entry.



Author(s): Write the author's last name, followed by a comma, then their first initial(s). If there is a second author use an ampersand (&) followed by the next author's last name, comma, and first initial(s). If the article was created by a group or organization, use the name of the group here, followed by a period.



Date: In parentheses, write the year, comma, month and day the article was posted, followed by a period. If there is no date listed, indicate "no date" using (n.d.).



Article Title: Write the title of the article, capitalizing the first word and leaving the rest in lowercase (unless it is a proper noun). If there is a colon, the first word after the colon is also capitalized and lowercase after that. Follow the title with a period.



Publication Title: Write the title of the news organization in italics, followed by a period.

Note: *This formatting is appropriate for online publications from companies with associated physical newspapers or magazines. If the news source is not associated with a physical publication, use the formatting for a website reference entry.*



URL: Include the URL for where the article can be found.
