Formatting: Double-space your reference list and use a 0.5 inch hanging indent for each entry.



Author(s): Write the author's last name, followed by a comma, then their first initial(s). If there is a second author use an ampersand (&) followed by the next author's last name, comma, and first initial(s). If the page was created by a group or organization, use the name of the group here, followed by a period.



Date: In parentheses, write the year, comma, month and day the page was last updated, followed by a period, e.g. (2021, September 16). If there is no date listed, indicate "no date" using (n.d.).



Page Title: Write the title of the page, capitalizing the first word and leaving the rest in lowercase (unless it is a proper noun). The title should be italicized and followed by a period.



Site Name: Write the name of the website, followed by a period. If the page was authored by a group or organization and the site name is the same, you can skip this.



Date Accessed: If the content of the page is likely to change, write "Retrieved" followed by the month, day, comma, year you accessed the information. This is followed by a comma and the word "from."



URL: Include the URL of the page you are referencing.
