
MLA Style (9th Edition): Works Cited

Lecture Slides from Course Website



Formatting: Double-space your Works Cited page and use a 0.5 inch hanging indent for each entry.



Author(s): Write your instructor's last name, a comma, and their first name followed by a period.



Lecture Title: In quotation marks, write the title of the lecture using title case (e.g. capitalizing all major words). Follow the title with a period placed before the closing quotation mark.



Course Title: Write the name of the course, followed by a period.



Course Website: In italics, write the name of the course website where the slides were posted (e.g. LEARN, Blackboard, Moodle, etc.), followed by a comma.



Publishing Institution: Write the name of the institution that published the course content, followed by a comma. The word "University" should be abbreviated using the letter "U."



Date: Write the day, month, and year the lecture slides were posted, followed by a comma.



URL: Add the course website's URL, removing the protocol (https://) from the beginning. Follow the URL with a period.



Format (optional): If it is unclear what type of source your citation is referring to, you can include the format or file type at the end of your citation, followed by a period.
