Formatting: Double-space your reference list and use a 0.5 inch hanging indent for each entry.



Inventor(s): Write the inventor's last name, a comma, and their first initial(s). If there is a second inventor, add a comma and an ampersand (&), then their last name, comma, first initial(s).



Date: Write the year the patent was issued in parentheses (round brackets), followed by a period.



Patent Title: Write the title of the patent in italics, capitalizing the first word and writing the following words in lowercase (except for proper nouns). If there is a subtitle, separate it from the main title using a colon (:). Capitalize the first word after the colon and write the rest of the subtitle in lowercase.



Patent Number: In parentheses, write the patent number, and follow the closing bracket with a period.



Patent Office: Write the name of the patent office that issued the patent, followed by a period.



URL (optional): If the URL to the patent is available, add it to the end of the reference.
