This citation recommendation is for use in class assignments at the University of Waterloo where you have been asked to use AI generated text as part of your work and provide a reference.

Formatting: Single-space each citation and indent the two or three spaces between citation number and the succeeding text.



Citation Number: Each citation refers to a number within the text of your writing. Enclose this number within square brackets aligned along the left margin. Indent the succeeding text 2 or 3 spaces.



Author(s): Use the name of the program rather than the parent company followed by a comma.



Response: Write 'response to author query' and end with a period.



Publisher: Use the name of the parent company rather than the name of the program followed by [Online] in brackets and end with a period.



URL: Write the URL of the medium's page you are referencing.



Date Accessed: In parenthesis, write the word 'accessed' and include the date you accessed the program written in the format of 'month day, year.' End with a period.



Note: Some assignments do not permit the use of ChatGPT or AI tools. **Please confirm with your course instructor or TA if a ChatBot tool is permitted.** If using a ChatBot, **you must cite** the content used to avoid Academic Misconduct.
